The heading of this article is the words of the same apostle when he wrote to the Romans for their spiritual enrichment. He was a useful weapon in the hands of God who fought for gospel without any shame and finally gave his neck to the Emperor Nero to test the sharpness of his sword. When he says that 'I am not ashamed of the gospel' there are many reasons for that we can see in the Scripture. At the same time we can see many martyrs like the beautiful girl of China to the old man Polycarp who were burned or thrown for the wild animals. They all sacrificed their life without any shame. Sometime Jim Elliot and his companions who were killed by the Aquas of Ecuador will be fools in front of the worldly people and those believers who are ashamed of gospel. But there is no doubt about that they are very valuable for their Master who stood up from the throne to receive the soul of Stephen.

It was very much encouraging to see that, about 10 to 15 years ago the working brothers used to take leave from their office and went for the YMEF gospel camps with great pleasure. They worked hard in the mountainous areas with great enthusiasm by eating the food what ever that were available and slept on the floor with leaf mats or even on palm leaves. And it was a good example that they brought their children also with them. They were not ashamed of the gospel and encouraged their children also for the gospel work. Today the things had changed. The concept among the Brethren about the gospel had changed. By the introduction of the new media the gospel is preached without any human effort. The importance of personal evangelism is forgotten. Only thing is that they also need some part in that.

Today people are looking for conferences and fests of thousands. They are ready to spend time and money for that. But for personal evangelism they are not at all interested. They say many lame excuses.

Dear children of God, it is very easy to speak on Sundays that "I am not ashamed of the gospel". Let us examine ourselves. Last one year how many house-visiting had been arranged? What is my participation in it? What was my role in the team work of our assembly like the YMEF? May be many of us might have spoke in the stages. But how many of us worked without shame for the gospel, visited houses, people and places? Let us correct ourselves. Let us go to the battle field with full armor and fight for the enlargement of the Kingdom of God. Let God help us for that.
