Y M E F (SD)

The Follow Up Work in Raichur

The Y M E F (SD) reached Raichur after sharing gospel in Kolar, Tumkur, Hoskote, Nelamangala, Belgam, Bidar and Gulberga. Initially the team stayed in the district head quarters of Raichur and worked there for six months. Then the team shifted to Lingusur and stayed there for another six months and shared gospel in each and every homes of Raichur district. During this one year the dear servants of the Lord visited thousands of houses a door to door ministry for the Master. Then itself certain fruits were seen and had the desire of a follo up campaign in many places. But because of the many limitations and difficulties the follow up campaign was postponed. But the Lord of hosts enabled us to begin this follow up campaign in November 2009 at this time.

But even before this brother Joseph was

conducting follow up in many villages. Because of the follow up conducted by him the Lord gave fruits to the Raichur Assembly and Gunjanahally Assembly. The follow up campaign which has started under the responsibility of the YMEF (SD) began to yield fruits in the form of Bible Classes in number of villages. We present these things for the glory of the Lord.

Kalmala: This is a very big village in Raichur which has more than 5000 houses. Virubhakshii one of the brothers of the village. He is working along with the team. A Bible class is going on this village on every Monday from 7.30pm to 9.30pm. More than 40 children 20 youths and few others regularly attend this classes. It is a thing worthy to be mentioned that the family members of brother Virubhakshii also attend these classes regularly.

Mandalagiri: This is a Kannada village in the

border of Karnataka and Andhra Prakash. There are onlt 250 houses in this small village. The inhabitants of this village can easily had both Telungu and Kannada. The one family that opened their house for gospel is the tallest one in the midst of the small huts of the illiterate and poor villagers. They sat in the courtyard of that house listening very carefully his word preached to them. When we se it few drops of tears of gratitude usually falls in to face.

Kalthamthotti: This is a Telungu village in Andhra Pradesh near the borders of Karnataka. There is a regular bible class in the village on every Sunday from 8pm. Nearly 70 people take part in these classes. 30 out of them are born again and they have expressed their willingness for baptism. It is a thing to be appreciated almost all the villagers take part in the special classes and meetings arranged by the YMEF team.

HAITI..... ANOTHER REMINDER?

The earthquakes at the Caribbean island of Haiti have a death toll of nearly 200 thousands. Thousands of buildings and houses like the palace of President, UN office, Parliament building, star Hotels and World Bank were destroyed. Many people were killed and the situation over that country is beyond explanation. People are starving without food and shelter. Their body and spirit are wounded. The children of God should pray for the people and for the rescue workers. The Haiti disaster is one among the ten great disasters that occurred in the world.

Once upon a time we thought that Kerala was a safe place. But today many wells are breaking down, water is rushing out through tube wells, earth is cracking in many places. Even though such news are surprising, the study about such incidents are in greater uncertainty. The Indian Institute of Science reports that the possibility of earthquakes in Kerala is much greater than twenty years ago. The number of water wells (above 4.5 millions), the leveling of mountains, filling of the wet lands and higher rate of quarry works are increasing the possibility of earthquakes. The Arabian Sea bed is unstable and it can occur with greater disaster at any time. Even though there were no casualties reported, Kerala has become a place of earthquakes. These types of incidents, the changes in the earth and natural calamities yet to happen are recorded in the word of God and it is a great surprise that the children of God are not worried about it. **Rev 6:12** I watched as the lamb opened the sixth seal. A powerful earthquake struck. **The sun turned as black** as sackcloth made of hair. **The full moon turned as red** as blood. **Rev 6:13** **The stars fell from the sky** to the earth like figs dropping from a fig tree when it is shaken by a strong wind.

Rev 6:14 **The sky vanished like a scroll being rolled up.** Every mountain and island was moved from its place.

Rev 6:15 Then the kings of the earth, the important people, the generals, the rich, the powerful, and all the slaves and free people hid themselves in caves and among the rocks in the mountains.

When **the coming of the Lord is at doorstep**, the people are running around in the midst of time shortage for the pleasures of the world.

When the fulfillment of the heavenly prophecy is completing and the end time is at the doorstep even the believers are running around to make the earthly living very comfortable. All our ministries are reduced to the decorated stage programme, when millions are dying without Christ and thrown to the eternal fire.

Kerala State once was known as the "God's own land" has now changed in to a land of terrorism and illegal activities. The Government is unable to protect the people from the fear of genocides, robbery, women trade and goondatism. Who is responsible for this? Is it the ever changing Government? When big buildings, palaces, multistoried hotels and even the huts were destroyed in Haiti, in Kerala the pride and greediness should be destroyed. If so, Haiti will be a permanent reminder in our life.

"A faithful man must be faithful to himself, then faithful to God, then faithful to others, particularly to the Church of God. Let me conclude by asking a genuine question.

Who am I?

Our path should be selected only by knowing our position. According to the word of God we are

the children of God. (Ro 8:16). If we are the children of God, can we continue to walk in the same way that we walk? Is it possible to walk with God at the same path? Samson walked without knowing his position and it ended at a great failure. Many people select the way without knowing the destination. We should know the destination before we start our journey.
