Namely that of men who, for personal gain, made it their business to divide the church into parties and to put stumbling blocks in the ways of the believers.

It may surprise us

that this kind of activity could have taken place in the apostolic age. But we should not forget that Satan has always been actively harassing the infant church then, and is still doing the same even in our time now. He is expert in using personal pride and carnal mindedness in some who may be leadership positions or in a teaching capacity, to feed a desire in them for supremacy among the flock.A proud and insubordinate spirit is a dangerous thing among those who are teachers of the Word both in a public and in a private capacity. We all,

sheep and shepherds, need to have dependence oil the grace Of our Lord, accompanied by a con-sciousness of the divine authority of the Scriptures of truth. We also need to realize that Truth has its source in Christ alone. Such a godly and a humble attitude would help to keep us right, but this is most important for those who are apt to teach.

The danger for those who are teach-ed among us is to have a tendency towards resorting to the thoughts of man rather

To teach them the word of God is very tedious because of their illiteracy. To overcome this task the grace of God is abundantly required. The presence of the Y M E F is a good help for this. Many evangelists from different parts of Karnataka are joining for the house visiting. If the people are interested they will revisit them and share the gospel. Fervent prayers are required for this blessed work. Planting new assemblies is the ultimate aim of this work. The

brothers who are in the field are Bros; SunderRaj, Praveen, Albert, Sathyananda, Gershom (Guruswamy), Virupakshi and Joseph from Karnataka. From Kerala Bros; Joy Philip, Vijaya Das and Kuriakose are also with them. The team is under the leadership of Brother Bhaskaran. The office bearers of Y M E F Kerala (SD) visited them twice.

YMEF(ND) TO RAJASTAN

God willing the Y M E F (ND) will start to Rajasthan on February 2010 for 3 months' gospel work. The districts Shri Ganga Nagar, Hanumanghattu and Jaysalmar are included in this campaign. The aim of this campaign is to reach gospel to all districts which was excluded in the last campaign. The first campaign in Rajasthan was in 1st October 1981, which was the 2nd North Indian campaign of the Y M E F team. In that programme the team worked for 5 months where our believers were present. After that they returned to Kerala and transmitted the need of evangelizing Rajasthan villages to the co-believers. As a result, from 2002 to 2005 the 32 districts of Rajasthan were evangelized. But they left every district by leaving behind hundreds of un-reached villages.

Rajasthan with 3,42,239 sq: KM of area is the largest state of India. The district Jaysalmar is greater than the state of Kerala. It is very sad to reveal that there are no churches or evangelical work in this district which has a long border with Pakistan. This is a great challenge to us. A smaller state like Kerala has got many churches and evangelical work. We are blessed in that respect. In our state at least once the gospel is heard by the people. But in Rajasthan thousands are left behind with out hearing the gospel never in their life. In the last campaign only very few villages of the district was able to reach. In the new campaign also we will not be able to reach all villages because the vast area. Even then the team is planning to evangelize as much as villages they can, so that many may be saved and many local assemblies will be started.

We have worked in the village called Shri Ganga Nagar. Bros Darshan Singh and Barish Francis are staying there with the family. There are small assemblies in some villages. But many villages are left behind. Because of the burden about those villages, the team has arranged this campaign. In Hanumangattu Bro P B Samuel is in ministry with the family. A small assembly is functioning there. In 2003 the team had worked for a month there. In that district also many un-reached villages are left behind. When we compare our work and area, we have done only very little. Therefore let us bow before Lord in tears. Let us look to the field which is ready for harvest. Let us go forward to pull out many from the eternal condemnation. Let God help us to fulfill His wish through our life.

Editorial

THE SHADES OF THE CANDLESTICK

I will not criticize members of other denominations or those who left the Brethren assembly for their daily needs and for a luxury life. I have no responsibility to respond to the writings of somebody who writes out of their anger and misunderstandings. Let them ask questions to their own conscience. This is only the fight and war cry of an individual at a period, when self-examination is inevitable. It is nothing more than cowardice to reply answer for the questions asked to the Brethren community, from other denominations.

The greatest blow to the present age is the shattering of Holy life of Brethren and the attack against sound doctrines. I am not expecting to correct everybody those who are ready to accept anything and discard everything and reconcile with other denominations which are away from the true doctrines. My aim is only to respond to the current subjects. I am not using my language to get appreciation from others but for expressing the ideas in the correct sense and to minimize the sharpness of the words without hurting others. Whether it is a constructive or destructive criticism, we should have some knowledge of literature and an open heart to understand and enjoy it. If the writers are in lack of language and ideas, let them ask God, without reproach, who gives liberally to all. (James 1:5).

Nobody can degrade the word of God and doctrinal truths by the human relationships and social commitments. I have no evidence from the history of Brethren, that our forefathers and Bible teachers ever shared the stages with the groups, who does not give importance to the sound doctrines. They are living examples of true Christian life. And they never agreed with the false teachers and those who fell down from the correct path and aim. The Brethren Church history is not a historical book of memories, but a measuring rod of the present Church life. If anything is against that let our servants of Lord come forward with courage and spiritual knowledge without using people from other denominations.

It is a vain work to suppress the enlightened people who are aware of the darkness which covered the spiritual world and who has got the burden about bringing the fact to the notice of the children of God. Even in great troubles there will be people who are ready to react against the matters which are painful to the pious heart.

The Brethren have no central government, local leadership, elected rulers, foreign control or human god. The freedom and individuality of our local assemblies are very important and it is a specialty. Even though we failed in many respect, we stand in that Biblical truth. Our basis is not the tradition, custom or works but it is the truths which we got through the apostolic examples and New Testament revelation of true doctrines. It is the responsibility of each and every believer of the assembly to learn the scripture, meditate it and be firm in it. All the believers should know how to be in the Church of living God, Who is the pillar of truth and the foundation.

At this situation all the elders of the assemblies should be very cautious. The local assembly is not an open field but a fenced garden. So anybody who co-operate with other false denominations without any separation in life and doctrines is to be disciplined according to the word of God. To implement this, able elders and teachers with good spiritual knowledge, spiritual maturity and good testimony are required. If not, our assemblies will become a movement without any aim which moves among the multitude.

with the harmlessness of doves (Matt. 10:16).

Human wisdom dictates that to guard yourself you must be thor-oughly acquainted with the world and all its evil ways. This is the wis-dom which James describes as being not from above but earthly sensual and demoniac. I need not as a child of God to know all about the wick-edness and the corruption that is in the world today nor do I have to cultivate an acquaintance with the depths of Satan. I need only to know all that is good in Christ and to de-light myself in knowing Him per-sonally. This is the wisdom that is from above which is first pure, then peaceable, gentle and easy to be en-treated. My ears have to be tuned to hearing the voice of the Shepherd

for I know not the voice of strang-ers and will not follow them. This should be the only path of safety for the child of God in a world that re-jected and crucified His Son.

And this world is now under the control of the prince of the power of the air who seems to be ruling su-preme over the hearts of its inhab-itants who know not God and who obey not the Gospel of our Lord Je-sus Christ.

The true child of God has the se-cret of victory over Satan in the cru-cifixion and the resurrection of the Savior, who through death has de-stroyed him that had the power of death, and then rose again victori-ous over death and hell. Yet I may not see in my state of infirmity now ,insign of ^a coming and final vic-tory over him. But the holy Spit-it here assures us that the God of peace shall bruise him under our feet (v. 20). ^{In} our impatience we may ask how long?

than to the Scriptures. To depend on our mental abilities in teaching may satisfy a sense of per-sonal importance. And it could well be met with excitement from some of the hearers who might be looking for novelty of ideas. Remember how the Athenians were always looking to hear about something new! (Act. 17:21). Such activity of the flesh may result in leading some of the weak in the flock astray; to the hurt of both hearers and speakers. Divine revela-tion in the

Scriptures and not man's thoughts about it, is the only means of guarding the glory of Christ and maintaining the well-being of be-lievers. Resorting to man's thoughts and expediencies may succeed in creating a school of thought, and in drawing disciples around a human leader, (Act. 20:30). But the sword Of the Spit-it, used by Him, will judge h flesh, nourish the new man in the believer and cause the edifica-tion of the body of Christ to the glo-ry of God.

The saints in Rome had to be warned against the activity of such men who, for their own purpose, caused schism in the body. The situation is not different today, for sadly we all know that the flesh in the believer always seeks its own glory not the glory of Christ. And there are still among us those who consciously or unconsciously pursue such a course in the assemblies.

The Holy Spirit judged that those Individuals in Rome were not ser-:mts of the Lord, even though they may have boasted of being so. The epression "their on belly" descibes their desire to satisfy their ppetites for recognition by others for the occupation of the place of no-toriety and for the wielding of authority

over the people of God. They may fake an appearance of superior spirituality, but the Spirit speaks ery negatively of their work.

Contrary to the doctrine taught to the believers and in the process their planning and scheming to have a following among the flock, they end up offending the saints especially the more innocent ones. Their methods of entering in were to use good words and fair speeches; has deceiving unsuspecting %Danger believers. But the saints in Rome had shown their obedience to the Lord that they were not taken in by the decep-tion of the false teachers. And their reputation in this regard has become well known to the other churches. This gave the apostle something to rejoice about, yet he found it nec-essary of urther warn them to be on guard for that continued danger.

What follows was an advice to them concerning the Divine remedy for what they were facing,
