LEADERSHIP IN THE HOUSE OF GOD

When the gospel was preached in Acts 2, it brought forth a tremendous response. About 3000 souls received the news with gladness and believed in a crucified, risen Saviour. So the work of the Holy Spirit of God through the "foolishness of preaching" (1Cor. 1:21) had commenced.

This first church at Jerusalem became the pattern to all the churches which would be planted in Judea, Samaria, and to the uttermost parts of the earth. Paul, writing to Thessalonica, says, "Ye brethren, became followers of the churches of God in Judea". So the principles and practices established were to be followed in every church until its witness on earth is finished at the coming of our Lord.

The pattern that was set at Jerusalem when they received the Word was to make their confession of faith public in baptism. Then they were committed to the apostles' doctrine, fellowship, breaking of bread, the prayers. What joy marked these saints even in severe persecution as they allowed the truths of Scripture to enrich their hearts. One thing, however, became effective and grow, elders had to be appointed.

God in His wisdom has seen fit to put the leadership of His people into the care of a plurality of men. Let us consider a few things with regard to this very important role in the local church.

The Recognition of Elders

There are those who say that because there are no apostles in the Church today, elders cannot be recognized in a public way. Others affirm that it is up to each individual to recognize the elder that they think fulfills the part. However, while there are no apostles today, the authority for elders comes from their doctrine which is in the Word of God.

Paul establishes that elders had to be in every city and Acts 14:23, (contd.. to page 2..)

THE GATHERING OF THE ASSEMBLY AND WORSHIP

The gathering of saints reveals the church. And it is the main function of the church. If there is no gathering there is no church. In that respect the knowledge about a church should be correct.

In Acts 20:7 we see that the disciples came together to 'break bread'. But it does not mean that gatherings are only for breaking bread. If so, there is no mention about the cup. It is a short form usage for the gathering. Both bread and wine are included there. That is very important.

In 1 Cor 11:17,18 apostle Paul clearly clarifies the meaning of 'breaking of bread'. In chapter 12 to 14 he mentioned about the spiritual gifts and brethren fellowship. In chapter 13 he exhorts three things which are greater than the spiritual gifts, that is Faith, Hope and Love(charity). And, out of these greatest is charity.

In chapter 14 he dictates how to utilize the spiritual gifts, which was the practice of the church in the first century. But now a days people adulterated the word of God. But we should understand the order and submit each other as a true gathering. In other words the Lord's Table and word ministry are inseparable parts of worship. Lord's Table is the crown of the worship.

Worship:- What is worship and what is not worship? One should know this. According to some people all ministries are worship. They say, 'funeral-worship', 'baptism-worship', 'wedding-worship' etc.

“IS IT A TIME TO RECEIVE MONEY, OLIVE YARDS AND VINEYARDS”

The question quoted above is the one asked by the prophet Elisha to his servant Gehazi centuries ago. If the prophet were alive today, to whom all, shinning in the spiritual world, would have he asked this question. The world is facing the greatest economic crises that it has ever witnessed. If we analyse this global destructive crises we find that it has not happened overnight but it began years ago. Philippians 1:1, and Titus 1:5 show that they were evidently recognized. In 1Peter 5:3 we learn that they are not “lords over God's heritage”, indicating that is not a dictatorship rule but through those from among themselves, not someone who came in from the outside. How sad to see many assemblies of God's people move away from clear scriptural leadership by bringing in men to take over a “pastoral” position. There is nowhere in the New Testament where saints are subject to one man, but are in subjection to a body of elders who are identified and recognized.

The Requirements for Elders

When we turn to 1Timothy 3, we have a list of essential features that ought to mark every elder in an assembly. First there has to be a personal desire for the work! Peter makes it clear that it is a willingness for the task and not one borne out of necessity.

In Acts 20:28, Paul makes it clear that this work is energised by the Holy Spirit. The ideal situation is that when the Holy Spirit calls a Man, there should be a personal

willingness to fulfil this very important ministry. How many have been exercised but not willing? How many have been willing but not exercised? Here are some personal qualities: devotion: the husband of one wife; deportment : of good behaviour; disposition: friendly, hospitable; disciplined : ruling his own household well; doctrinally sound: apt to teach; diligent: watching for souls (Heb. 13:17); dedicated : whose faith follow (Heb. 13:7)

The Responsibility from the Elders

Having considered personal characteristics of the elders and what work they discharge in relation to the assembly, we now move from the personal and look at their collective work.

The Lord Jesus in John 10:27 as the Good Shepherds says, “My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me”. The work of the elders has been likened to shepherds in their care for the sheep. One of the most important aspects of their ministry is *to know the flock*--that is every member in the assembly. This is where true spiritual discernment

come in and elders should be able to observe the condition of the saints. There are many who have gone into ‘By-path Meadow’ who may have been spared from it . Shepherd care should see the commencement of departure and draw alongside to help. The need is great to “weep with those that weep and rejoice with those who rejoice”.

Secondly, the elder should *feed the flock!* David in psalm 23:2 says of his Shepherd that, “He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: He leadeth me beside the still waters”. Dear elders, are you making sure the believers are getting good, wholesome, spiritual food to keep them strong and healthy? Are you substituting something in your assembly for “sound doctrine”?

Thirdly, the elder in the assembly should be diligent to *guard the flock* from false teachers (Titus 1:9) Also in Acts 20:29-30, where Paul warns that grievous wolves will come in “not sparing the flock”, and that men would arise up from among themselves, speaking perverse things. In the dark and difficult

days in which we live, elders need to be on guard to protect the saints from every cold wind of evil doctrine that is blowing.

Finally, the elder have to be an example to thee flock so that the saint have confidence in them. The true Shepherd leads the way and His sheep follow because they know His voice. What a calming and assuring effect He has because they have come to know and trust him.

The Respect to the Elders

There are four things the assembly is asked to do in relation to the elders who are over them in the Lord. In Hebrews 13:7; they have to be remembered for their rule, ministry, faith, and manner of life. The ultimate objective of life and service was “Jesus Christ, the same yesterday today and forever”.

In Hebrews 13:17, the saints are *exhorted to obey them*. You may not always agree with their decisions but remember they alone are responsible to give an account before the Lord. You may not know why they make the decisions they do because of confidentiality, but give them your support and leave the results with the Lord. In 1 Timothy 5:17,

they have to be *honoured*. Especially they who labour in the word and doctrine. Then in James 5:14, they have to be called in times of sickness for prayer. What tremendous support there is in times of extreme need when we can look to the elders of the assembly for intercession before The Throne of Grace.

The Reward for Elders

It is true that often the role of the elders from a human perspective can be a thankless task. When everything is going well, they receive very little thanks, but when things go wrong, well- you know what happens! However, the Lord, the righteous judge, will give a true assessment of the service rendered and will reward accordingly.

Many an elder has weathered the storm and remained faithful through trying assembly conditions, but what a day lies ahead when the faithful elders will hear the Saviour say, “Well done, thou good and faithful servantenter thou into the joy of thy Lord”.

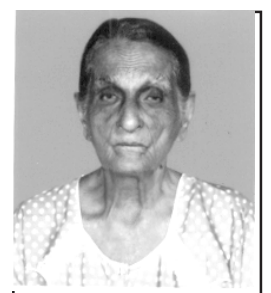

These are not worship, but different services. There is worship in the services but they are not the worship.

Fellowship:- This is the interaction among the believers. This should be in different fields like co-operation, work together, financial sharing etc. (Ref. Gal. 2:9; 1Jn 1:3,6,7; Gal. 6:6-10; Phi. 1:5; 4:15; Rom. 12:13)

Lor's Table:- The usage 'break the bread' denotes, Lord's Table and Worship. (Ref. Acts 2:46; 20:7-11; 1 Cori. 10:16,17,21; 11:20,20-34.) In the beginning there was daily worship (Acts. 2:44-47). But further we see in Acts. 20:6,7 upon the first day of the week. The command and order about the Lord's

Table can be seen in the following ref. Matt.26:26-29; Mark. 14:22-25; Luke. 22:19,20; 1 Cori. 10:16,17; 11:23-31. We break a single bread. Not by a single man but by us. We drink from one cup not from many cups. These things we have to practice.

Prayer:- In the gathering there is prayer – A prayer of one accord. (Acts. 4:23-31; 12:5-17; Eph.6:18-20) A prayer meeting is not a time if preaching or not a time of exhibiting the gifts. It should be a group prayer with single mind. We can give a list of prayer matters. We can encourage each other through scripture for prayer but it should be a prayer meeting and not something else.

The Church:- Even if some members of the gathering are not present, the church is there. If somebody is absent for a longtime without any genuine reason, his membership perishes. Because the church is the gathering of the saints. So when a man gets out of this fellowship, he is out of the church.

1.Acts 11:26 we read, "And it came to pass that a whole year they assembled themselves with the church". In Greek the word 'Ecclesia' for church is also means the assembly of citizens.

2.In 1 Cori. 11:18 we read that " when you

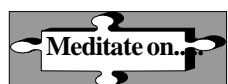
come together in the church" means when you gather together. 1 Cori. 14:34 we read "Let your women keep silence in the churches" - that is in the gathering of saints.
