**We will not neglect the house of God (Neh 10:30)**

In the book of Nehemiah chapter 10 verses 28 to 39 we see a group of people who turned to God with spiritual decisions. We can see 6 references in connection with the covenant. The sign of

the revival is to come back the covenant and live according to the

word of God. In the spiritual circle the action and elocution are considered as the revival.

In Nehemiah 9:26 we read that they denied the word, but in 10:28 we see their decision to come back to the word of God. For successful Christian life proper decisions has got an important roll. In the beginning of the New Year it is good time for good decisions. In verse 31 we see that they made an ordinance. The devil is always against making good decisions. In verse 32

to 39 we can see the decisions in connection with the temple of God. The two New Testament truths which the house of God shows are very important. In 1Cor3:16 and in 6; 19 we see our body as the temple of God. Our body is purchased by our Lord by giving His own precious blood. But the Corinthians lived by forgetting the important truth. Therefore the apostle asked them - "Do you not know that your bodies are the members of Christ?" (1Cor6:15). We are not supposed to use our body for unholy purposes.

## HOW TO FACE THE OPPOSITION TO THE GOSPEL

In India the opposition to the gospel is increasing. What had happened in Orissa is very painful. In Kandamal the situation was very bad. The reporters said that it will break the heart of any cruel man. But apart from some minor loss many of our halls and institutions were safe. It was only by the care of our God. Praise the Lord for that.

By this time many people thought about a confederation of Independent Assemblies, for the Brethren Assemblies union to react against such oppositions. It was heard that one brother had made an outline for this union with the help of a lawyer. It is a sad act from the younger generation. These youngsters are not aware of our previous church history. There were able children of God among us always for any memorandum. When the central government tried to introduce Christian Marriage Bill, a group of elders with Bro V. T. Mathai went to Delhi for protest. O.P. Thyagi brought a bill for anti conversion during the time of Desai. But that entire attempt went in vain. And God helped the Y M E F team to go to Bahrich in U P which was the place of O P Thyagi and preach gospel. The power of darkness can not stop the power of gospel. Making a confederation! Is it a remedy for the crisis? This idea is against the word of God. Opposition for the gospel is right from the first century. When Apostle Paul and John were warned what they did? Did they go to a lawyer? See Acts 4: 23-31. They asked for God's mercy to encourage them to speak the word. Let it be our prayer also. The Catholic Church has got the greatest power of confederation. They have their representation in Delhi also. Their ambassador can put influence on Indian

Government. But in Orissa the sisters suffered too much. How brutally they were raped? The world wide confederation did not help there. But we have to remember one thing that we serve a living and powerful God. The God of Daniel lives for us. Acts of Apostles explains the persecutions of the church and believers. Paul was jailed at its climax. But what did Paul do in the Roman prison? He received all who visited him with great joy and preached gospel. (Acts 28:29, 30). There is no prison for the word of God. The opposition in Orissa is not a new incident. In 1980 we faced very strong oppositions. But in the middle of that God worked and helped us wonderfully. The oppositions will increase. Some people are worried about our identity. But we have the identity as the Brethren. The Brethren are known every where in the world. The people are aware of our doctrines. In the beginning our forefathers never took any name. But we were known as the Brethren. We do not require any other identity. There is an open door for gospel in front of us. Our blessed lord has got the key of King David, and He can close and nobody can open it. In Rev 3:8 we read that "See I have set before an open door and no one can shut it". Many of the north Indian Villages is calling us. The Lord's servant V. Nagal sang like this - **Even if the Satan brings the whole army of this world, our heavenly father will smile at that and we will have the victory.** Dear children of God when the God who has got all the power on earth and heaven, why we are worried? Let us go forward with the banner of gospel. May our God help us.

Those lived unholy life had paid heavily for that. In 2sam 11-18 we read the consequences of the lustful eye of King David. The same trap is used by many soap companies now a day for their advertisement. We see David's decision for his sanctification in Ps 101:2, 3 who suffered much for his sins. "I will walk within my house with a perfect heart, I will set nothing wicked before my eyes." Let us materialize a holy life in the New Year.

Another truth about the house of God is seen in 1 Thes3; 15. A local church is the house of the living God. The explanation of the book of Nehemiah is meaningful in connection with the church. The children of God said that we will not leave the house of God.

Previously they forsake the house of God. In 2 Chro 24:18 we read like this- "Therefore they left the house of God of their fathers. Leaving the house of God is a terrible sin. The prophet Haggai in his book chap 1 verse 4 asks like this "Is it time for you yourselves to dwell in your paneled houses, and this temple lie in ruins?" I am afraid of myself, when we worship the Lord in the rotten assembly halls and spend lakhs of rupees to paint our mansions. The book of Haggai enlightens us. When they heard the word they repented. The leaders and the ordinary people were revived. They worked in the house of Lord (Hag1:14). Let the Lord stir up our mind. As our bride-groom as the pioneer, let us work for the local assembly.

**1. Let us love the church as Christ loved the church (Eph5:25)**

Those who love Christ can not forget the church which is loved by Christ. Those who ignore the church will be ignored by our bride-groom. Some gospel teams will not allow to speak about the church. They forget the basic principles of **church-planting** in the evangelical work (Acts2:47). Those who love the church will love the bride-groom and they will love the brothers (1Jn5:1). the church of Ephesus was that she left her first love. The spiritual death was the wrinkle of the church of Sardis. A child of God who presents himself for the church can live without spot and wrinkle. Then he can restore others in the spirit of gentleness.

**3. Let us comfort the church as Christ comforted**

Our Lord nourishes and cherishes the church. Bro. Nagel sung that the Lord bears the weakness of the believers. Apostle Paul took this example at the church of Thessalonica. (1The2:8).

God has given spiritual gifts to all church members. These gifts are for common use. In 1Pet 4:10 we see that - "As each one has received a gift, minister it one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.

Let us do it with politeness and respects with the only aim of the glory of God. Those who follow the Lord will have successful church life. And they will be respected in the heaven. "To him who over comes I will grant to sit with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with my Father on His throne. (Rev3:21). God punished those who ignored the house of God. The prophet Haggai repeatedly said, "Consider your ways" (1:5, 7. 2:15, 18.). There are crisis everywhere in the world for jobs. The reason behind this is because the children of God gave more importance for it than God. Let us examine ourselves and come back to the house of God and re-dedicate ourselves. Let the New Year be a good start with repentance.
