Wanted: Heart Prickers!

“Shallow preaching begets, at best, shallow converts.”

Something is amiss in the pulpit today. We are in urgent need of heart-prickers.

Review the public messages given in the Book of Acts. How often is the preacher applauded for his insightful message? How often are accolades heaped upon his oratory? Never! Consistently, God measures His work, and His workers, by results. Souls saved. Lives changed. Testimonies strengthened. That is what the Lord seeks.

The first fruits that became a great harvest at Pentecost were pricked hearts. (Acts 2:37) Pricked hearts demanded action, “what shall we do?” Then came repentance leading to salvation. No minds broadened here. No kudos

given to Peter for having introduced some new ideas (they were new, but the Spirit focused not on newness but on heart responses). No funds sought; none counted. No head count of the audience. No buildings built. No project volunteers. Just souls saved — about 3,000 of them.

Oh, for more heart-prickers today! We do not need orators. Oratory is good, but only if seasoned with the Power of God. We do not need pseudo-intellectuals. Proud intellect should be laid aside in the prayer closet, so that God’s servant can mount the pulpit to give simple expression to the greatest story ever told in humble dependence upon His Lord. Headwork has never changed a life; heartwork does. The Lord can only use in the pulpit men whose hearts He has first touched. Then they can touch other hearts for Him.

Heart-prickers do not build

buildings, they build His Church. Heart-prickers will be more likely to empty churches than fill them. Their work will tend to fill heaven instead. The message of the heart-pricker demands a response: Repent or rebel. Those who repent will follow Christ. The others will go away. Too often today the “success” of a preacher is measured by the size of his following and not in terms of the number following Christ as a result of his labours. Generally, man-pleasing preachers build large followings. And when the blind lead the blind, they both fall into the ditch.

The heart-pricker is not a fundraiser. He deals in a richer currency; he seeks souls. Modern evangelism has reached the heights of mass marketing skill. It can raise tens of millions, span continents, build networks.

What is God?

of an equilateral triangle. At the same time there are no three Gods. In the whole scripture we see the three personalities of Trinity. (Gen 1:1-3, Isa 48:16, 2 Cor 13, Mat 28:3).

There are occasions in which the three persons

are revealed. (Mat3.13-17, Mark 9: 7-9, Luke 4:18). We are created with Spirit, Body and Soul to reveal the trinity. Let us take a decision to obey the triune God, who created, redeemed and comforting us.

These people gave light to the world even in the Dark Age. God preserved some believers like the Philadelphian believers. And that light illuminated during the time of reformation. But the trend of the end time is entirely different. Many writers write and speakers speak about the the diminution of values of our period.

Stages and publishing houses are filled with the cry of the same the subject. The financial growth of the world is the main root cause. "I am rich, I want nothing" this is the attitude. But the young generation forgets about the real richness. The true proof for this can be seen through the attractive publications, dazzling convention notices, world's high class posters of music festivals and gigantic cut outs. Presentation of pure Gospel through the word of God has given way for pleasing prophesy of prosperity. Today's music also shows the spiritual value diminution. How and where the failure begin? Mainly in two fields. First one is hypocrisy. The word is preached with great enthusiasm. But it is only on and outward act. The listeners are not moved spiritually.

Second is the spiritual laziness of like at the time of Eli. A sleeping nature of the God's people without doing the work, without saying what is to be said, without pointing out the mistakes, without taking any disciplinary action and without correcting at the needed place, caused considerable damages to the spirituality. The leaders are attracted only by the chairs and flattery. The children of God who were called and separated have failed in these two fields.

The conferences, family meets camps and conventions are like waves of the sea without the proper treatment for the ailment. There is no place for self justification or ego. Self examination is the correct proper remedy.

A spiritual man examines every thing. When we do something, remember that God is watching it. Can we do it with that fear? But when we look to the believers deeds, we may doubt in their belief. How many arrows are darted towards the children of God? Remember these arrows are directed to the eyes of God. Many of the rituals of the gentiles became the daily routine of the children of God. The people lost their vision just like the time of Eli. The Biblical truths are lost from the life of believers. The gentile King Nebuchadnezzar understood the mighty power of the great God who is Omnipotent and omniscient. Nothing will happen in the life of the children of God without His permission. The heading of this article is the words spoken to Job, when he was trying to justify himself. Beware! God is going to ask you something. "Now prepare yourself like a man. I will question you, and you will answer me?"

Dear children of God, there are no short cuts for a return. May God help us to lead a life according to the will of God. Let us depend on God who laid the foundation of earth and hanged it upon nothing. God will again soak this dry generation spiritually with His drops of dew. Let us pray and wait for it.

But what about souls that are perishing? Disgusting personal habits are called "diseases," not sin. Morality becomes a relative value. Sin and repentance are down-played, in light of the idea that a loving God will accept everybody ... especially if he pays!

The heart-pricker does not deal in social issues. He has a higher mission. His issue is Christ or the world, heaven or hell, repentance or eternal death. Let the dead bury their dead issues; let us preach Christ, and Him crucified.

Where are the tears in our messages? Where are the souls coming in an anguish of conviction, seeking relief in Christ? Too often, our services end in lightness, and are followed by gay chatter and idle gossip ... because hearts have not been pricked. **Shallow preaching begets, at best, shallow converts, who fill buildings on Sunday. But, alas, will they help to fill heaven for eternity?**

Consider: Does a heart-pricker occupy your pulpit? Even sometimes? We've got a lot of people in pulpits

today who cannot — or will not — preach the gospel. And, in spiritual terms, they are useless. A dying world and a lukewarm church needs heart-prickers. May God raise them up, so that our pulpits will burn anew with messages that demand an answer.

Where can heart-prickers be found? Not in the world. Not in human organizations. Not in man's schools. Our pulpits need men who come from God; men who have been with the Lord. Who have learned — and accepted His message. Who have grasped His urgency. Who have been endowed with His Power.

The true Church needs to learn anew to leave enter-taining to the entertainers, apologetics to the dead intellectuals, fundraising to Madison Avenue, social issues to the politicians. The true Church has far more urgent, far more important things to do. But to do what the Lord left us here to do, we need a new generation of heart-prickers in our pulpits.

Finding Our Calling

A continuing struggle as we seek to follow Christ is trying to find our calling in life. While we often think in terms of occupation and location, perhaps a more important issue is one of character - the being that under girds doing. "Lord who do You want me to be.?"

Other Tongues — Is it Necessary Today?

Gifts has been given to the children of God for the smooth functioning of the local assemblies. (Rom 12:6-12, 1Cor 12: 28-31, Ephesians 4:11-16, 1Peter 4:9-11). We can see about the gifts in these four portions of the scripture. A. The scriptures that speak of the gift of other tongues In the day of Pentecost Acts 2 In the house of Cornelius Acts 10: 14 Ephesus Acts 19:14.

These are

three portions where people spoke in other tongue in the first century. The three chapters of 1Corinthians 12, 13, 14. This book gives details about other tongue and its mode of using it.

B. Other tongues is a sign for unbelievers
1Cor 1:22

The Jews generally believed on signs and miracles 1Cor 1:22. It was a sign for Jewish unbelievers. In Pentecost the Apostles spoke in tongues to make the Jews believe that the apostles spoke great things of God. In Chapter 10 of Acts the Lord wanted the Jews who followed Apostle Peter to believe that gentiles too can have Holy Spirit if they accepted Christ as their personal savior and Lord. Anyone who believes, will be gifted with the Holy Spirit in the unchanging nature of God was proved to the Jewish believer in the house of

Cornelius. Jews accepted it and they had to accept this fact from that incident.

The Conditions to use the gift of the tongue. Only two or three are permitted in a congregation 1Cor 14:27.

One has to follow another and not all are permitted together 1Cor 14:27.

An interpreter is a must when one speaks in other tongues.

Women should hold their silence 1Cor 14:34

When gifts are utilized under the control of the Holy Spirit the use of tongues should be according to those instructions. Do we have this type of gift in the present.

The Purpose of gift of tongues It is a sign of unbelievers and not believers 1Cor 14:22

To confirm the Word of God Mark 16:20; Hebrews 2: 3,4

For the spiritual edification of the

church !Cor 14:12, 28
For the benefit of all 1Cor 12:27

For the glory of the Triune God 1Pet 4:11. Whether there are tongues they will cease 1Cor 13:8

She got the chance to nurse a fatally wounded military officer. He recovered soon because of her nursing care. She was once a slave in the same officer's house. He recognized her. He said "Why you did not kill me? She replied him that she was the slave of Jesus who prayed for those who crucified Him. So she

could not do that Christ has taught me to love my enemies. These words were beyond his expectation and it shook him. That military officer accepted Jesus Christ as his Saviour and Lord.
